

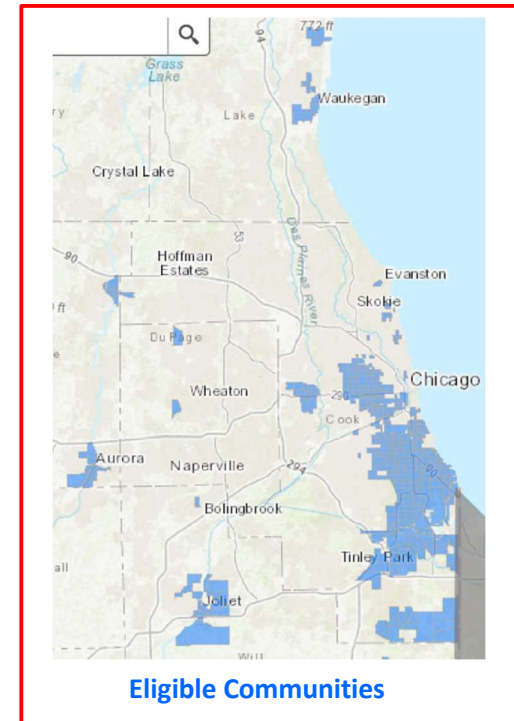
# THE ILLINOIS CLIMATE AND EQUITABLE JOBS ACT (CEJA)

CEJA passed on September 15, 2021, and promotes clean energy, an equitable workforce transition, electric vehicles, and energy efficiency in buildings.

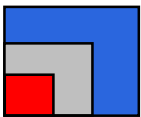

- Carbon free power by 2045
- Clean Jobs Workforce Network Program (training hubs)
- Climate Bank
- Community Energy and Climate Plans
- Department of Transportation Study on Electric Vehicle Impact on Transportation Infrastructure Funds due 9/30/22
- Electric vehicle consumer rebates begin 7/1/22
- Electric vehicle charging station rebates begin 7/1/22
- Financial support for nuclear plants
- Financing for municipal utilities Equitable Energy Upgrade Program (Pay As You Save)
- Low-income weatherization expanded
- Net metering municipal policy updates due 3/15/22
- Public Schools Carbon-Free Assessment Program

- 40% set aside for Eligible and Environmental Justice communities
