

TIPS FOR ACCEPTING DONATIONS





WORK WITH A WEB DEVELOPER

Consider searching for local volunteers or freelancers that can help create a button on your site that leads to a payment processor that is directly linked to a bank account.



THANK YOU NOTES + TAX RECEIPTS

You can set your site up to send an auto-generated response. Alternatively, you can send individual emails or letters to those who donate online or in-person respectively. Personalization is also a nice touch. If your organization is registered as a 501(c)(3) with the IRS, make sure to include the words below (edited with your group's information) as it is required for tax receipts.

KEEP A SPREADSHEET OF DONATIONS
