

COMMUNITY SOLAR PROCESS



- Community Solar asset delivers energy to the Local Utility.
- Local Utility delivers blended energy to consumers
- Local Utility applies on-bill credits to Community Solar Subscribers.
- Subscribers pay a portion of their on-bill credits to the Community Solar developer



COMMUNITY SOLAR IN ILLINOIS

Limited Opportunity

- Funding for approximately 117 MW of projects in the ComEd region
- ~187,000 MWh of annual generation
- ~0.2% of entire ComEd load requirements

Random Project Funding

- Approximately 1,200MW of projects under development 10x what can be funded
- A lottery will be used to randomly award projects with SREC contracts
- Impossible to know which projects will be available for subscriptions.

Rate Complexity

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•Not all accounts will save money with subscriptions

WHY PARTICIPATE IN THE CS² PROGRAM?

Positive Economics

- Smaller municipal accounts likely to secure 5-15% savings long term
- All municipalities have at least some accounts that will benefit even Franchise accounts.
- Nominal cost to participating municipalities to defray start up costs

Progress on Sustainability

- Municipalities can directly support new solar development in the region
- Can serve as a response to the growing "100% Renewable" campaigns

Manageable Level of Effort

- Municipality provides copies of most recent ComEd bills for each account
- CS² will identify which accounts can capture savings
- Municipality can decide whether to enroll accounts into the CS² program

Expression of Interest & Utility Bill Upload (MMC Members, mid-Nov)

No-Cost Account Evaluation (MMC/Power Bureau, late-Nov) Identify accounts that can save money

Supplier RFQ (MMC/Power Bureau, mid-Dec) •Identify qualified developers; establish subscription price range

Supplier RFP (MMC/Power Bureau, early-January 2019) • Conditional selection of developers and pricing

IPA Lottery (IPA, Feb 2019)

•We learn which community solar projects from step 4 can be contracted
